GUIDE TO CREATING A CORRECT PRINT FILE

The following guidelines are intended to help you create a correct print file. If you still have doubts, please consult our website or request our graphics service.

FILE FORMAT

For the best result a **vector PDF** file is reccomended (1:1 scale)

If a vector file is not available, **JPG** and **PNG** file with high resolution (at least 300 DPI) are also acceptable Maximum dimension: **8 MB**

In the case of PDF, the file must not be password protected



RESOLUTION

The optimal resolution for the print files is 300 dpi



COLOURS

The same color may appear slightly different depending on the substrate This is due to the physical composition of the material

EXPRESS PRINTED CARDS:

All files must be sent in **RGB**

The images in CMYK or with PANTONE colours will be automatically converted with a standard output profile

ALL OTHER CUSTOMIZED PRODUCTS (stickers, offset printed cards, PVC tags, business cards, etc.):

All files must be sent in **CMYK**

RGB or PANTONE color images will be automatically converted to a standard output profile

FOR MONOCHROME PRINTS

The logo must be sent using only **one** color without gradients

The files can be both in CMYK and RGB

PANTONE colors are only possible in offset printing (we recommend contacting us in advance for a better printing result)

FONTS and PATHS

The fonts will have to be converted into **curves/paths**The minimum font size (beyond which we do not guarantee perfect print quality) is **6 pt**The distance of the texts from the edges must be at least **2 mm**

MARGINS and BLEED

The file for printing must be in 1:1 scale and have at least 2 mm of bleed on each side

CARDS:

the file size with graphics including bleed must be 89,6 x 58 mm

> STICKERS:

for example, if the labels chosen have a diameter of 29 mm, the graphics must have a diameter of 31 mm

please consider **2 mm** of internal margin as "safe area" **Do not** insert important elements less than 2mm from the edge









FRAMES and PASSE-PARTOUT

We do not recommend placing frames or passe-partout too close to the margins to avoid inaccuracies due to printing tolerances.

In order to avoid unsatisfactory results, the frames must not be positioned less than 2 mm from the edge









ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Do not insert cutting marks

As for the express printed cards, we recommend that you do not send graphics with large areas of solid color, as the result may not be optimal due to technical limitations of this type of printing.

Also, for what concerns any express printing, we do not send a proof of print before proceeding unless explicitly requested in the form.

To be sure of the rendering of a particular color, we invite you to request a photo of the first item printed.
